

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
FAILURE TO COMPLETE CORRECTIVE ACTIONS
WEIRTON AREA WATER BOARD, WV3300516**

Our water system violated State drinking water requirement. Even though these were not emergencies, you, as our customers, have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation (See table below).

An on-site evaluation of our system is conducted on a regular basis. Results of the evaluation show significant deficiencies in our water system which must be addressed to the Office of Environmental Health Services- District Office. We did not correct these deficiencies by the required date, and therefore are in violation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the deficiencies that require corrective action.

Required Corrective Action	Corrective Action Required by:
Failure to correct significant deficiencies	Within 120 days of written notification

What happened? What is being done?

The Weirton Area Water Board replied to the Sanitary Survey but did not outline a written time frame of when deficiencies would be corrected. Plans were in place to make corrective measures based on when the funds would be available. As required, The Corrective Action Plan has been completed including when corrective actions will be taken. As of the Jan. 2018 Water Board Meeting, an engineering firm was contracted to begin the bidding process for tank refurbishment. This is one of our deficiencies in this notice.
